

CZECH COMBAT 2026 Tactical Competition 10.-12. 7. 2026

Competitor's Equipment List (CEL)

Competitors must start at all stages with all mandatory equipment according their division!

1. FULL GEAR DIVISION:

- 1.1.1 Rifle cat. B (semi-auto) in a rifle caliber (only women - cat. "Lady" are allowed to start with the Pistol Caliber Carbines) on the sling (silencers, weapon mounted lasers and flashlights are legal in the Czech Republic).
- 1.1.2 Service semi-auto pistol (cat. B) in a hard case holster on the belt. Revolvers are not allowed.
- 1.1.3 Eyes and Ears protection (active ear protection is highly recommended).
- 1.1.4 A sling on rifles is mandatory.
- 1.1.5 A chamber flag is mandatory.
- 1.1.6 Helmet - protective helmet (ballistic helmets are NOT mandatory but only recommended).
- 1.1.7 Clothing - a combat uniform with long sleeves in any pattern or single color.
- 1.1.8 Shoes – duty type with ankle protection.
- 1.1.9 Plate Carrier - body ballistic protection with a minimum level of protection IIIA is mandatory, ideally in the form of ballistic plates with a resistance of at least "III++" or NIJ 06 lvl. IV/RF2 (protection against 5,56×45 SS109 green tip; 7,62×39 etc.).
- 1.1.10 Gloves with full fingers covered - hand protection.
- 1.1.11 Shooters or a service belt.
- 1.1.12 Minimum of 5 magazines up to maximum 30 rounds each per primary weapon. Minimum amount of rifle ammo for Czech Combat is 150 rounds. We recommend bringing double – 300 rounds. If you cannot operate the high-capacity magazines or get the exception, write a letter to your EU representatives.
- 1.1.13 Minimum of 4 magazines up to maximum 20 rounds each per secondary weapon. Minimum amount of pistol ammo for Czech Combat is 80 rounds. We recommend bringing double – 160 rounds.
- 1.1.14 The limits for the capacity of magazines – rifle magazines – up to 30 rounds; pistol magazines – up to 20 rounds.
- 1.1.15 Training TQ – C-A-T (6th or 7th gen.), SOFTT or SAM XT or others recommended by T3C Committee
- 1.1.16 **Functional GAS MASK with filter** (if you cannot bring your own, we will provide you with some universal type).

2. LIGHT HOBBY DIVISION

If you cannot pass Full Gear Division, we offer you participation in Light Hobby Division. Light Hobby competitors have their own classification and cannot be awarded in some type of awards like CZECH COMBAT TEAM challenge, High Senior or High Lady!

- 2.1.1. Rifle cat. B (semi-auto) in a rifle caliber (only women are allowed to start with the Pistol Caliber Carbines) on the sling (silencers, weapon mounted lasers and flashlights are legal in the Czech Republic).
- 2.1.2. Service semi-auto pistol (cat. B) in a hard case holster on the belt. Revolvers are not allowed.
- 2.1.3. Eyes and Ears protection.
- 2.1.4. A sling on rifles is mandatory.
- 2.1.5. A chamber flag is mandatory.
- 2.1.6. Clothing - long sleeves trousers and shirt are mandatory.
- 2.1.7. Gloves with fingers covered - hand protection.
- 2.1.8. Shooters belt.
- 2.1.9. **Small backpack (20-30 l) for carrying the weight in some stages.**
- 2.1.10. Minimum of 5 magazines up to maximum 30 rounds each per primary weapon. Minimum amount of rifle ammo for Czech Combat is 150 rounds. We recommend bringing double – 300 rounds.
- 2.1.11. Minimum of 4 magazines up to maximum 20 rounds each per secondary weapon. Minimum amount of pistol ammo for Czech Combat is 80 rounds. We recommend bringing double – 160 rounds.
- 2.1.12. The limits for the capacity of magazines – rifle magazines – up to 30 rounds; pistol magazines – up to 20 rounds.
- 2.1.13. **Functional GAS MASK with filter** (if you cannot bring your own, we will provide you with some universal type).
